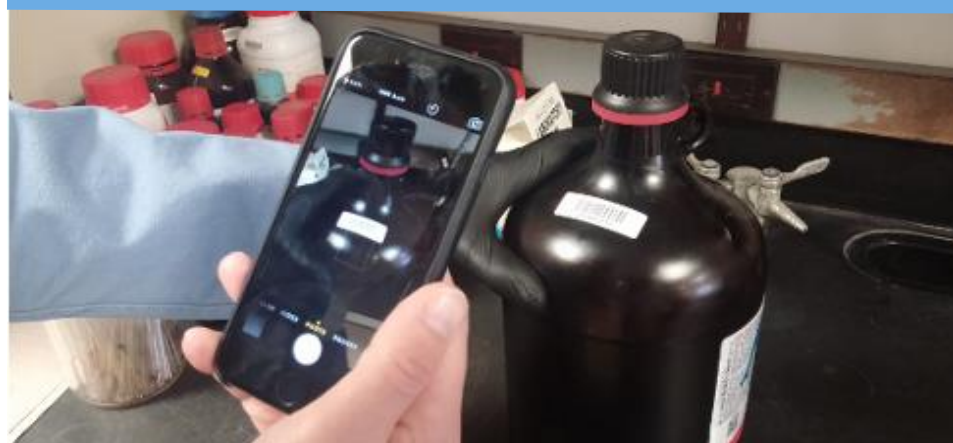
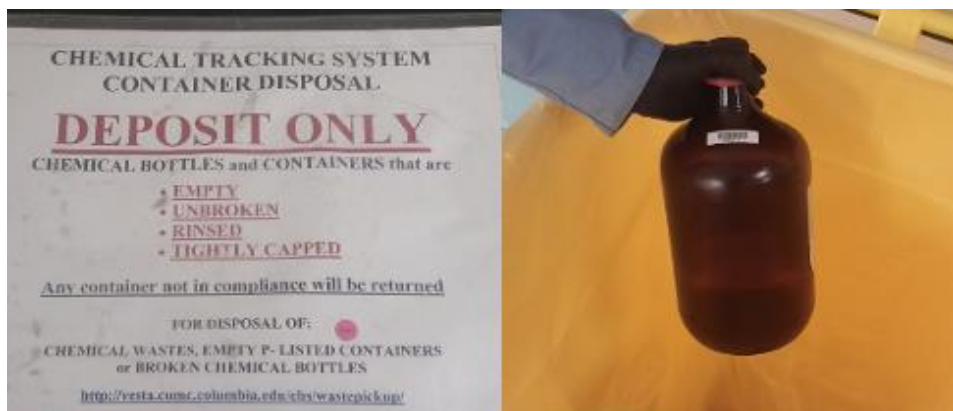


INSIDER'S GUIDE TO CHEMTRACKER RECYCLE OR REUSE EMPTY CONTAINERS



3 OPTIONS



1. *THE CLASSIC*

As long as it was not a P-listed chemical*, the empty container goes in the yellow bin for recycling.

2. *THE SLIP*

Peel off the barcode and stick it to a piece of scrap paper. Drop the paper in the bin. Reuse the container.

3. *THE SMARTPHONE*

Take a photo of the barcode & email it with “empty” to chemtracker@columbia.edu.

Reuse the container.

If you're a scientist today, you're probably conscious of recycling. Or maybe you just find it convenient to reuse your 4L amber bottles for liquid waste collection!

* Bottles with a  sticker are collected as hazardous waste.
